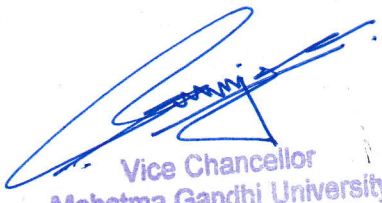

Preamble

A university that admits international scholars accepts an obligation beyond the ordinary duties owed to its domestic intake: it becomes answerable, simultaneously, to its academic regulator, to the immigration and foreign-affairs authorities of the Republic of India, and to the sending student's own expectation of fair and orderly treatment. **Mahatma Gandhi University, Meghalaya** ("the University") frames this Policy to discharge that layered obligation in a single, transparent instrument.

This Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme for Foreign/International Students governs the eligibility, selection, supervision, fee, visa, residence, and conduct requirements applicable to foreign nationals - and to wards of Indian nationals employed in Gulf countries admitted under the equivalent category - seeking admission to the Ph.D. programme of the University. It has been framed in conformity with Regulation 7 of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022 ("the UGC Regulations, 2022"), Annexure I of Ordinance - 1 of 2023 of the University ("the Ordinance"), and applicable Government of India instructions on the admission of foreign nationals to Indian universities, including those issued through the Study in India programme and by the Ministry of External Affairs and the Bureau of Immigration from time to time.

Save as this Policy expressly provides otherwise for matters particular to the international/foreign-national category - namely routing of admission, equivalence of qualifications, fee structure, visa and residence compliance, and disciplinary jurisdiction - every foreign scholar admitted to the Ph.D. programme remains subject, in all other respects, to the University's Research Policy, the Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme, the Fellowship/Scholarship Policy for Ph.D. Scholars (to the extent applicable), the Constitution of the Ethics Board, the Constitution of the RAC and DRC, and the Policy for the Grievance Redress Mechanism of Scholars, on terms identical to those applicable to Indian scholars.

1. Short Title, Applicability and Commencement

1. **Short Title.** This document shall be called the "Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme for Foreign/International Students of Mahatma Gandhi University, Meghalaya."
2. **Applicability.** This Policy applies to all foreign nationals who apply for, or are admitted to, the Ph.D. programme or any other research programme of

the University, and to wards of Indian nationals employed in Gulf-region countries who are admitted under the terms of clause 4.3 below. Where a discrepancy exists between the general Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme and this Policy in respect of a foreign or international candidate, this Policy shall prevail to the extent of the matters it specifically regulates.

3. **Commencement.** This Policy shall come into force on the date of its approval by the both Statutory bodies i.e., Academic Council and ratification by the Board of Management, and shall apply to every admission of a foreign national occurring thereafter.

2. Definitions

Terms used in this Policy carry the meanings assigned in Regulation 2 of the UGC Regulations, 2022 and Chapter 2 of the Ordinance. In particular:

- **“Foreign National” / “Foreign Student”** means a candidate who is not a citizen of India within the meaning of the Citizenship Act, 1955, and who holds a valid passport issued by a foreign government.
- **“Foreign Educational Institution”** has the meaning assigned in Regulation 2(1)(k) of the UGC Regulations, 2022 - an institution duly established or incorporated in its home country, offering programmes at the undergraduate, postgraduate and higher levels through conventional face-to-face mode, and excluding distance, online, or Open and Distance Learning mode.
- **“Dean, IR/FA”** means the Dean, International Relations/Foreign Affairs of the University, through whom all admissions of foreign nationals shall be routed.
- **“AIU”** means the Association of Indian Universities, whose equivalence determinations govern the recognition of foreign qualifications for the purposes of this Policy.
- **“Supernumerary Seat”** means a Ph.D. seat allocated to a foreign scholar in addition to, and without displacing, the regular seats and supervisory ceiling otherwise available to a Research Supervisor.
- **“Equivalence Certificate”** means the certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities certifying that a foreign qualification is equivalent to a corresponding Indian qualification for the purpose of admission.

3. Guiding Principles

- Admission of foreign nationals shall be conducted through a single, identifiable channel - the Office of the Dean, IR/FA - so that no ambiguity arises as to the authority responsible for a foreign applicant's file at any stage.
- Save for the modifications expressly set out in this Policy, a foreign scholar shall be subject to the same academic rigour, coursework, supervision, evaluation, and integrity standards as an Indian scholar; nationality shall never be a ground for dilution of academic requirements.
- The University shall conduct the admission of foreign nationals in a manner consistent with applicable Government of India instructions on foreign student admission, immigration law, and the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010, where relevant to fee remittance or sponsorship.
- A foreign scholar's academic and personal conduct while in India shall be subject to the disciplinary and legal jurisdiction applicable within the Republic of India, in addition to the University's own disciplinary framework.

4. Eligibility Criteria for Admission

4.1 Persons Eligible to Apply Under This Policy

This Policy applies to (a) foreign nationals of any country who apply for admission to the Ph.D. programme, and (b) wards of Indian nationals employed in Gulf-region countries, who may apply under this category subject to clause 4.3 below. No other category of applicant may claim admission under the terms of this Policy.

4.2 Academic Eligibility

4. A foreign national seeking admission to the Ph.D. programme shall hold a Postgraduate/Master's degree, or an equivalent qualification in the relevant subject, with a minimum of **55% marks**, from an institution recognised or listed by the UGC/AIU for such purpose.
5. Where the awarding institution or examining board is not included in the AIU list, the applicant shall obtain and submit an **Equivalence Certificate** from the Association of Indian Universities; the decision on equivalence of the degree shall be taken having regard to the recommendation of the Equivalence Committee constituted by the University for this purpose.

6. The course or qualification on which eligibility is claimed must be included in the list maintained by the Association of Indian Universities.
7. The Vice-Chancellor may, in exceptional circumstances and having regard to the nomination of the candidate or the candidate's demonstrated intellectual capacity to undertake meaningful research, relax the condition of minimum marks at the time of interview, subject to a committee constituted by the University for such purpose recording its concurrence.

4.3 Gulf-Country Ward Category

Only foreign students and wards of Indian nationals working in Gulf-region countries shall be eligible to apply under the ward category described in this clause. The eligibility conditions applicable to Indian nationals working in Gulf countries, for the purpose of this category, shall remain the same as those applicable to Indian nationals generally under the Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme, and not the modified conditions applicable to foreign nationals under clause 4.2 above.

5. Admission Procedure and Routing

8. **Routing through Dean, IR/FA.** Admission of foreign nationals to the Ph.D. programme shall be routed exclusively through the Office of the Dean, International Relations/Foreign Affairs. A prospective foreign applicant may approach the Dean, IR/FA at any time during the academic year for guidance on admission to the programme.
9. **Admission outside the standard cycle.** Unlike Indian applicants, who are ordinarily admitted within the notified admission cycle, an international scholar may be admitted at any point during the academic session. Where a scholar is so admitted, the scholar shall be permitted to submit the Research Proposal/synopsis before the commencement of coursework, in accordance with Chapter 14, clause 10 of Annexure I of the Ordinance.
10. **Selection Process.** The University may determine its own selection process for the admission of international students, having regard to the guidelines and norms issued in this regard by the UGC and other statutory/regulatory bodies from time to time, in accordance with Regulation 7(2) of the UGC Regulations, 2022. Save as this Policy provides otherwise, the academic assessment of a foreign candidate's research proposal and aptitude shall follow the same substantive standard applied to Indian candidates under the Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme.

6. The Foreign Student Admission Committee

The admission of foreign nationals shall be considered by an Admission Committee comprising:

Designation on Committee	Office Held
Member	Dean (Academic Affairs)
Member	Dean, International Relations/Foreign Affairs (Dean, IR/FA)
Member	Chairperson of the Department concerned

The interview for admission of a foreign national shall be conducted by this Committee, through online or offline mode as the circumstances require. Where the discipline concerned also requires assessment by the Research Advisory Committee, the Committee shall coordinate its evaluation with the RAC so that the candidate's research proposal is assessed with the same rigour applied to Indian candidates.

7. Supervisory Allocation and Supernumerary Seats

- Every regular teacher of the University's teaching Departments with at least five (5) years of teaching experience shall be entitled to one supernumerary seat for the purpose of guiding and supervising a foreign national, over and above the supervisory ceiling otherwise prescribed under Regulation 6(3) of the UGC Regulations, 2022 and Section 7.2 of the Research Policy.
- A teacher with two (2) years or less of active service remaining before superannuation shall not be granted any supernumerary or other seat to guide a foreign scholar.
- The allocation of a Research Supervisor to a foreign scholar shall be decided by the mutual consent of the supervisor and the scholar, after due consideration of the supervisor's area of specialisation and the scholar's research interest.
- Save for the supernumerary allowance described above, all other conditions governing Research Supervisors under the Research Policy and Regulation 6 of the UGC Regulations, 2022 - including eligibility, co-supervision, and restriction near superannuation - apply without modification to the supervision of foreign scholars.

8. Applicability of the General Ph.D. Ordinance

The conditions laid down in the Ph.D. Ordinance notified by the University Grants Commission, and given effect through the University's Research Policy and Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme, shall be strictly followed in respect of foreign scholars, except for those conditions relating specifically to the admission process, which are governed instead by this Policy for the purpose of regulating the affairs of foreign students admitted to the programme. Coursework, credit requirements, periodic review by the Research Advisory Committee, plagiarism screening, thesis evaluation, and viva-voce procedure apply to foreign scholars on terms identical to those applicable to Indian scholars.

9. Fee Structure

Foreign nationals admitted to the Ph.D. programme shall be charged the fees set out below, payable annually in Indian Rupee equivalent at the exchange rate prevailing on the date of payment, as notified by the Reserve Bank of India:

Faculty Category	Annual Fee (USD equivalent, payable in INR)
Non-Science Faculties (Humanities, Law, Social Sciences, Education, Commerce & Management, and allied disciplines)	USD 1980 per year
Science Faculties (Physical Sciences, Engineering, and Life Sciences)	USD 2,000 per year

The fee structure above shall be reviewed periodically by the Board of Management and may be revised by notification; any such revision shall not operate retrospectively against a scholar already admitted, save with the scholar's consent or as required by a binding change in Government of India policy. In addition, to the above, foreign scholars shall be liable for such caution deposits, admission processing fees, and other charges as may be notified in the international student prospectus issued by the Office of the Dean, IR/FA.

10. Documentation, Attestation and Equivalence

- All documents required for admission shall be attested by the Embassy, High Commission, or Consulate of the country concerned situated in India; documents submitted without such attestation shall be summarily rejected.
- Foreign nationals applying from their own country shall obtain attestation of their transcripts and certificates from the concerned accredited government agency of that country, duly certified additionally by the Indian Embassy or Consulate in that country, as the case may be.
- Where transcripts and certificates are not in the English language, a duly attested English translation shall be provided wherever necessary.
- A character certificate from the head of the institution last attended by the applicant is mandatory for admission to the Ph.D. programme.
- Where the awarding institution or board is not on the AIU list, the applicant shall submit an Equivalence Certificate from the Association of Indian Universities as described in clause 4.2 above.

11. Visa and Immigration Compliance

11. **Student Visa.** Foreign students admitted to the Ph.D. programme are required to obtain a long-term Student Visa in the name of Mahatma Gandhi University, Meghalaya, on the basis of their admission, within one (1) month from the date of admission, and shall submit the visa to the Office of the Dean, IR/FA.
12. **Failure to obtain Visa.** Where a scholar fails to obtain and submit the Student Visa within the prescribed period, the University reserves the right to cancel the admission. In such an event, the admitted scholar may claim a refund of fees paid, which shall be refunded after deduction of USD 100 (in equivalent Indian Rupees at the Reserve Bank of India buying rate prevailing on the date of refund) as an admission processing fee.
13. **Condonation of Delay.** The Vice-Chancellor may condone any delay in the submission or procurement of the visa or other documents required for continuation of admission, having regard to the circumstances placed before the Vice-Chancellor by the scholar.
14. **Police Registration.** Within fourteen (14) days of arrival, every admitted foreign scholar shall submit, to the Office of the Dean, International Students' Affairs, for the purpose of police registration at the local Police

Station, the following documents: an attested photocopy of the passport, the visa, proof of residence, proof of admission, four passport-size photographs, and such other documents as may be required by the Office of the Dean, IR/FA.

12. Conduct, Discipline and Cancellation of Admission

If a foreign scholar is found to be indulging in any illegal activity, the scholar's admission shall stand cancelled immediately. The decision in this regard shall be taken by a Committee comprising the Proctor, the Dean, International Relations/Foreign Affairs, and the Dean (Research). This provision is in addition to, and not in substitution for, the disciplinary and integrity provisions applicable to every scholar under the Research Policy, the Constitution of the Ethics Board, and applicable University disciplinary rules.

A foreign scholar remains, at all times during their stay in India, subject to the ordinary criminal and civil law of the Republic of India and of the State of Meghalaya, in addition to the University's own disciplinary jurisdiction; nothing in this Policy limits the operation of that law.

13. General Guidelines

- These guidelines apply to all foreign nationals who apply for, or are admitted to, the Ph.D. programme or any other research programme of the University.
- All conditions applicable to Indian nationals admitted to the Ph.D. programme shall apply equally to foreign scholars, save for the modifications expressly made by this Policy in respect of the admission process, fee structure, and visa/residence compliance.
- Since an international scholar may be admitted at any point during the academic session, such a scholar shall be permitted to submit the synopsis/Research Proposal before the commencement of coursework, notwithstanding the standard sequencing that applies to Indian applicants.

14. Interpretation and Final Authority

The final authority for interpreting the rules and guidelines contained in this Policy, or for condoning any delay or irregularity of a procedural nature arising under it, shall rest with the Vice-Chancellor. Any dispute relating to the affairs

of a foreign scholar governed by this Policy shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the civil courts of the State of Meghalaya.

15. Relationship with Other University Policies

This Policy operates as part of the same regulatory architecture as the University's Research Policy, the Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme, the Fellowship/Scholarship Policy for Ph.D. Scholars, the Constitution of the Ethics Board, the Constitution of the RAC and DRC, and the Policy for the Grievance Redress Mechanism of Scholars. Save for the specific modifications this Policy makes in respect of foreign nationals, every other provision of those instruments applies to foreign scholars without distinction. In the event of an apparent conflict between this Policy and any of those instruments on a matter this Policy specifically regulates, this Policy shall prevail; on any other matter, the general instrument shall prevail. Any unresolved conflict shall be referred to the Research Degree Committee and, failing resolution there, to the Academic Council, whose decision shall be final, subject always to the overriding force of the UGC Regulations, 2022 and applicable Government of India policy on foreign student admission.

16. Amendment, Review and Interpretation

15. **Periodic Review.** This Policy shall be reviewed by the Research Degree Committee, in consultation with the Office of the Dean, IR/FA, at least once every three (3) years, or earlier where warranted by a change in the UGC Regulations, 2022, Government of India foreign-student policy, or immigration law, and any resulting amendment shall be placed before the Academic Council and the Board of Management for approval.
16. **Interim Directions.** Pending formal amendment, the Vice-Chancellor may issue such interim directions as are necessary to bring the University's practice into conformity with a change in applicable law or regulation, such directions to be ratified at the next meeting of the Academic Council.
17. **Effective Date.** This Policy shall take effect from the date of its approval by the Board of Management and shall apply to every admission of a foreign national occurring thereafter; foreign scholars already admitted shall, save as the Research Degree Committee may otherwise direct in the interest of equity, continue to be governed by the provisions in force at the time of their admission, to the extent those provisions are not inconsistent with binding statutory direction.

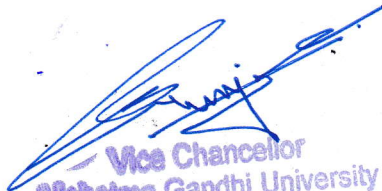

ADMISSION POLICY FOR THE PH.D. PROGRAMME FOR FOREIGN / INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The Dean (Research), in consultation with the Dean (International Relations/Foreign Affairs), placed before the Board the draft “**Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme for Foreign / International Students**”, framed in conformity with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022, Annexure I of Ordinance No. 1 of 2023 of Mahatma Gandhi University, Meghalaya, and the applicable Government of India guidelines governing admission of foreign nationals to Indian Universities, for consideration and approval.

The Board examined the draft Policy in detail and observed that it establishes a comprehensive institutional framework governing admission of foreign and international scholars by prescribing eligibility criteria, recognition and equivalence of foreign qualifications, admission procedures, constitution of the Foreign Student Admission Committee, supervisory allocation through supernumerary seats, fee structure, visa and immigration compliance, documentation requirements, disciplinary jurisdiction, interpretation and institutional responsibilities while ensuring full compliance with the applicable statutory and regulatory framework.

RESOLVED THAT

The Board of Management hereby approves the “**Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme for Foreign / International Students**” as the official institutional policy governing admission, registration and academic administration of foreign and international scholars admitted to the Ph.D. Programme of Mahatma Gandhi University, Meghalaya.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT

The provisions of the approved Policy shall apply to every foreign national and every ward of an Indian national employed in Gulf-region countries admitted under the category specified therein, subject to the provisions of the University Grants Commission Regulations, applicable Government of India guidelines, immigration laws and other statutory requirements.

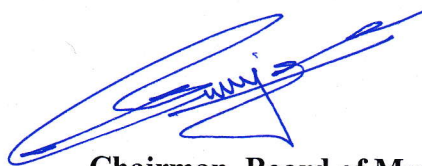

ADMISSION POLICY FOR THE PH.D. PROGRAMME FOR FOREIGN / INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The Dean (Research), in consultation with the Dean (International Relations/Foreign Affairs), placed before the Academic Council the draft **"Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme for Foreign / International Students"** for consideration and academic approval.

The Council examined the draft Policy in detail and observed that it establishes a transparent academic framework for admission and regulation of foreign scholars while maintaining parity in academic standards with Indian scholars, ensuring appropriate recognition of foreign qualifications, research supervision, coursework, evaluation, visa compliance and integration with the University's Research Policy and other academic regulations.

RESOLVED THAT

The Academic Council hereby approves the **"Admission Policy for the Ph.D. Programme for Foreign / International Students"** from the academic standpoint and recommends the same to the Board of Management for statutory approval.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT

Upon approval by the Board of Management, the Policy shall form an integral part of the University's academic and research governance framework governing admission and academic administration of foreign and international Ph.D. Scholars.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT

The Dean (International Relations/Foreign Affairs), Dean (Research), Research Degree Committee and Foreign Student Admission Committee shall periodically review implementation of the Policy and recommend appropriate amendments whenever required by changes in UGC Regulations, Government of India policies or immigration laws.

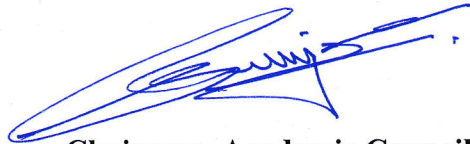

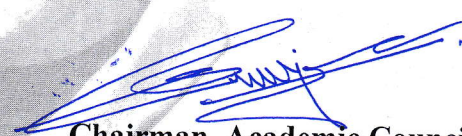
